Dress Code 2026

Gowensville Christian School has a standardized dress code. The ultimate goal with our dress code is modesty and professionalism. Since the time spent in class is limited, we would ask that dress code not become an issue. If you arrive at GCS dressed immodestly or inappropriately, your parent will be called to bring appropriate clothes to school. Please adhere to this dress code and sign the requirements stated below.

Students taking Physical Education may change into pre-approved athletic wear during lunchtime.

	Acceptable:	Not Acceptable:
Shirts	- Any solid or patterned shirts (small logo approved on the upper left or right chest area) - Sleeveless solid or patterned shirts with at least 2 inch thick straps - Sweaters - Sweatshirts - Hoodies - T-shirts with appropriate print/logos are allowed ONLY on Fridays	- Clothing that does not fit reasonably or is tight - Logos, slogans, words, or pictures promoting or depicting alcohol, tobacco, drugs, vandalism, bigotry, violence, sexual connotations, or profanity. This includes clothing with phrases or pictures that have double meanings. - Clothing that is revealing or immodest, or tops that expose bare midriff or undergarments - T-shirts, solid or patterned shirts with any print/logo larger than a business card on the front or any print on the back EXCEPT on Fridays.
Pants	- Any color traditional pants/jeans - straight, flared, cargo, twill, or denim/twill - Any color capris - Any color shorts, skirts, and dresses of appropriate length. - Any color leggings ONLY if worn underneath an appropriate shirt/dress length listed below by grade 3rd-6th: Shorts, skirts, and dresses must reach at least to the fingertips. 7th-12th: Shorts, skirts, and dresses must reach at least 2 inches above the top of the kneecap.	- Athletic or 'Athleisure' pants/shorts of any type at appropriate length EXCEPT on Fridays - Leggings - No frayed holes/tears or edges - No pajamas - Yoga pants - Pants must be worn at the natural waistline, and undergarments are not to be visible.



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Accessories, Appearance, Hair

- Shoe color and style are at the parents' discretion.
- Proper shoes must be worn at all times (no bare feet allowed)
 - Sneakers
 - Sandals with straps
 - Boots
 - Slip-ons with a back
- Tidy haircuts
- Natural Haircolor - Single or minimal streaks of unnatural color that are not distracting must be **PRE-APPROVED**.

- No slippers, slides, flip flops (sandals, crocs, etc. must have a strap)
- Crocs and similar slip-ons without a back may be worn on Fridays **ONLY**
- Wearing accessories or clothing that could pose a safety threat to oneself or others
- Any make-up or adornment that causes a distraction
- Hair that is distracting or extreme
- Hats or sunglasses worn indoors or incorrectly
- Boys' hair must not brush or surpass a shirt collar in length

Dress Down Fridays

- Students may wear t-shirts on Fridays.
- Athletic pants and shorts of appropriate length and fit must adhere to dress code rules
 - 3rd-6th fingertip
 - 7th-12th 2 inches above the top of the kneecap
- Crocs or other backless slip-on shoes

Please note:

- This is not a time to wear whatever you would like.
- All clothes that are worn during Dress Down Fridays must still abide by dress code modesty guidelines.
